



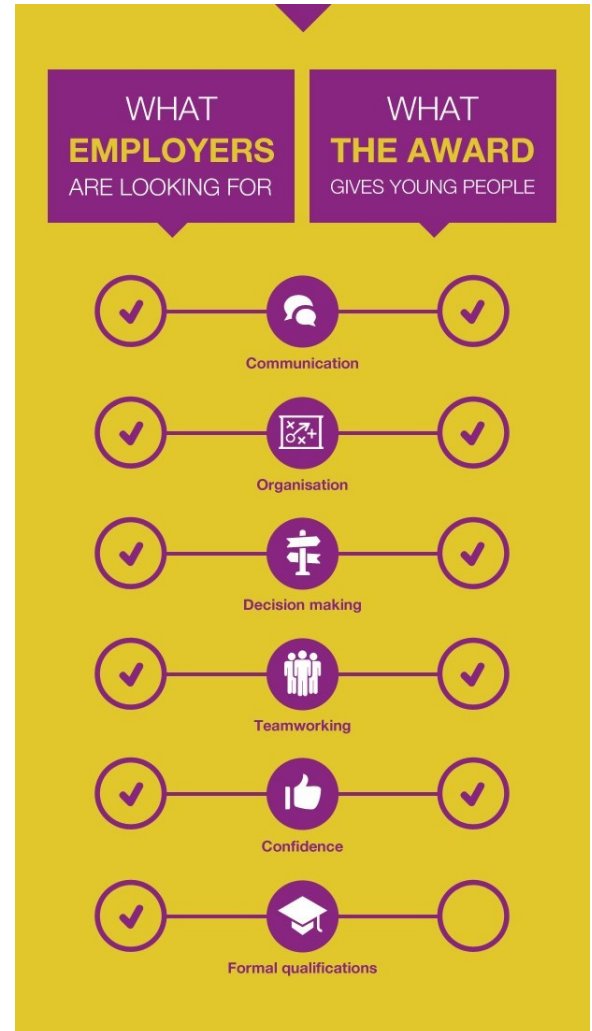
The Duke of Edinburgh Award is open to anyone 14-24 years old. It is gained through individual improvement and achievement and offers the opportunity for growth and development.

It is internationally recognized, looks good on post-secondary applications and shows employers your commitment, dedication and engagement for personal growth.

There are 3 levels; bronze, silver and gold. Each level requires the participant to participate for a particular number of weeks (26 for bronze) and hours (1 hr per week) committed to better themselves through Community Service, Skill Building & Physical Recreation. The Adventurous Journey encourages your spirit of adventure.

BYTOWN BRIGANTINE & THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH AWARD

Community Service	Bytown Brigantine is a charitable organization. Work parties including ship and small boat maintenance, shop work, community events and partnerships, etc. meet the community service requirement.
Skill Building	Define the rank you wish to achieve this year (winter through summer) and work on a weekly basis on skills to meet this achievement.
Physical Recreation	While this is not something Bytown Brigantine offers, you can join a club at school, take an exercise class or have your soccer, hockey, curling practice meet this requirement.
Adventurous Journey	All Bytown Brigantine camps and voyages count towards this component.
